"Six months ago in Karsana, Abuja, I inaugurated the first phase of our ambitious housing initiative, the Renewed Hope City and Estate. This project is the first of six we have planned across the nation's geopolitical zones. Each of these cities will have a minimum of 1,000 housing units, with Karsana itself set to deliver 3,112 units.



In addition to these city projects, we are also launching the Renewed Hope Estates in every state, each comprising 500 housing units. Our goal is to complete a total of 100,000 housing units over the next three years. This initiative is not only about providing homes but also about creating thousands of jobs across the nation as well as stimulating economic growth."

RENEWED HOPE CITIES AND ESTATES PROGRAMME



Overview

The Renewed Hope Cities & Estates Programme is a comprehensive nationwide housing delivery programme of the Federal Government, launched by His Excellency, President Bola Ahmed Tinubu, GCFR, in February 2024. Under Phase One, the Ministry of Housing and Urban Development plans to deliver 50,000 housing units, comprising seven (7) Cities, one in each geopolitical zone and the Federal Capital Territory, and one (1) Estate in each of the remaining thirty (30) states of the country.

The Cities will have 1,000 housing units per site, while the Estates will have 500 housing units per site in the remaining thirty (30) States.

The Renewed Hope Cities have been designed as integrated living communities targeting all income brackets, and comprising one-bedroom blocks of flats, two-bedroom blocks of flats and three-bedroom blocks of flats; two-, three- and four-bedroom terraces, four-bedroom duplexes, and five-bedroom duplexes.

On the other hand, the Renewed Hope Estates have been designed to cater to low- and medium-income earners. They comprise one, two-, and three-bedroom semi-detached bungalows.

Furthermore, the program aims to address social inequality by providing a broad range of affordable ownership options. This includes single digit and up to 30-year mortgage loans to be provided by the Federal Mortgage Bank of Nigeria, Rent-to-Own options where beneficiaries can move in and pay towards homeownership in monthly, quarterly, or annual instalments and Outright Purchase for high income earners.

The funding for these projects will come from a mix of sponsors comprising the Federal Ministry of Housing and Urban Development's budgetary allocation, the Federal Mortgage Bank of Nigeria (FMBN), and Public Private Partnerships with reputable developers.



TIMELINE

FEBRUARY 2024

Groundbreaking for 3,112-housing unit Renewed Hope City at Karsana, Abuja by His Excellency, President Bola Ahmed Tinubu, GCFR. The Project is part of a 100,000-housing unit Public-Private Partnership arrangement with a consortium of developers, with 20,000 units to be delivered in the FCT.

MAY 2024

Groundbreaking for First Leg of Nationwide Renewed Hope Cities & Estates for a total of 1,500 housing units. This comprised a 500-unit Renewed Hope City in Kano, and 250 housing units in two states each of the North-west and Northeast geopolitical zones, namely Katsina, Gombe, Yobe, and Sokoto States. The projects have a delivery time frame of three (3) months.

JUNE 2024

Grounbreaking for Second Leg of Nationwide Renewed Hope Cities & Estates for a total of 2,000 housing units. This comprised 250 units in two states in each of the other four (4) geopolitical zones, including Ebonyi, Abia, Akwa Ibom, Delta, Oyo, Osun, Benue, and Nasarawa states.

Total Number of Units Inaugurated: 6,612

Funding

The Renewed Hope City in Karsana is fully funded by the consortium of private developers, while the Renewed Hope City in Kano and all inaugurated Renewed Hope Estates were funded by the Federal Government under the 2023 Supplementary Budget.

Number of Jobs Created

165,500 Skilled and Unskilled Jobs created in the first round. The 50,000 units to be delivered in the first phase will create 1,250,000 jobs for skilled and unskilled workers, earning an average of 35,000 per week at N5,000 daily.

Renewed Hope

Cities

Under the Renewed Hope Cities and Estates
Programme, the Federal Government intends to
build seven (7) cities, one in each geopolitical zone
of the country and the FCT.

Each estate will have an average of 1,000 housing units of various house types. So far, there have been groundbreaking in two locations; the FCT and Kano State. While the FCT project is part of a 100,000 housing unit Public-Private Partnership arrangement funded by private developers, the Kano Renewed Hope City is fully funded by the Federal Government under the 2023 Supplementary Budget, with the state government supporting with land.

Groundbreaking for the other **five (5) locations**will be done in the course of the year,
under the 2024 Budget.


















Renewed Hope

Estates

The Renewed Hope Estates is part of the Renewed Hope Cities and Estates Programme of the Federal Government to be built in **30 states** across the federation. So far, Groundbreaking has been done in **12 states** under the 2023

Supplementary Budget.

An average of **500 housing units** are to be built in each of the states, comprising various house types of **1, 2, and 3-Bedroom Semi-detached Bungalows** to cater to all income brackets.

The Estates are fully funded by the Federal Government, with the states providing the land at no cost to bring down the cost of construction and enhance affordability. States not covered in this round will be covered under the 2024 Budget of the Ministry.










